
## **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. Artists are welcome to enter up to 2 original artworks in a range of media painting, prints, drawing, photography, collage, sculpture and other 3D construction for example.
- 2. All works on paper must be framed with hanging string securely attached to the back. Works on canvas must be framed or have a rigid support and hanging string must also be attached securely to the reverse side of all work. For abstract works, please indicate which way the work is to be hung.
- 3. Each work must be labelled on the back with the TITLE, FULL NAME, ADDRESS AND & SALE PRICE (if for sale), or NFS (not for sale). Please use the blank cutout labels on this leaflet.
- 4. Artists are welcome to submit a short piece of text of up to 150 words with their artwork, describing the piece, its inspiration, how it was produced etc. This will be typed up into a label and displayed alongside the artwork.
- 5. All entrants must live within the borough of Tameside and work must have been produced within the last year.
- 6. It costs £1 per painting to enter Open Art. This goes towards covering the costs of holding the exhibition.


- 7. All work should be delivered to Astley Cheetham Art Gallery (not the library counter) on these dates: Saturday 8 June 10am-2.30pm, Monday 10 June 9am-12.30pm, Tuesday 11 June 9am-12.30pm, Wednesday 12 June 1pm-4.30pm, Saturday 15 June 10am-2.30pm. No work will be accepted after these dates. All packing to be removed. No handling assistance available. Please note that access to the gallery is via a set of stairs only.
- 8. Once the exhibition has finished, artists should collect their work within two weeks of the exhibition ending. The gallery cannot be held responsible for work not collected after these dates.
- 9. From any sale of work the gallery will retain a commission of 25%. If your work sells TMBC will ask for your bank details to pay the money directly into your bank account. Please note your details will not be kept.
- 10. Although every care will be taken, artists enter works at their own risk. Tameside Museums & Galleries Service cannot be held liable for loss, theft or damage howsoever caused whether by negligence or otherwise whilst the works are on the gallery premises.
- 11. Our privacy policy regarding our Open Art database is available to view at the gallery.
