  - i. Mulbery Street Car Park, Ashton OL6 6EL
  - ii. Union Street Car Park, Ashton OL6 6JA
  - iii. Beeley Street Car Park, Hyde SK14 1ND
- 2. In addition to the existing Charges for the car parks, Licensed Driver's will be subject to the additional charges for charging their Licensed Vehicles as set out in Schedule 1 of the Proposed Order.
- To benefit from these facilities, All Greater Manchester Licensed Drivers must register as a
  member online <a href="https://account.be-ev.co.uk/">https://account.be-ev.co.uk/</a> and visit one of TfGM's Travelshops in Greater
  Manchester with their Be.EV membership email address and taxi badge(s) as issued by
  their local authority.

This Order is intended to come into operation on 10 May 2023 or as soon as possible thereafter.

### **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

## TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT) (No.1) ORDER 2023

Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to make the above named Order ("the Proposed Order") as an amendment to the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009. The proposed Order will:

- Introduce Electric Vehicle charging points for the use of a Greater Manchester licensed taxi driver (Hackney or Private Hire) within a licensed Electric Vehicle (Hackney or Private Hire) in the following locations:
  - i. Mulbery Street Car Park, Ashton OL6 6EL
  - ii. Union Street Car Park, Ashton OL6 6JA
  - iii. Beeley Street Car Park, Hyde SK14 1ND

As set out in Schedule 1 to the Proposed Order.

The Proposed Order seeks to introduce a scheme by Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) to make charging easier and more accessible for taxi drivers and to encourage more taxi drivers to switch to greener and more sustainable vehicles.

- 1. The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 amended as set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 2. The Order shall come into force on and will be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Order) (Amendment) (No.1) 2023.
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### **SCHEDULE 1**

1. In Part I (General) insert in article 2 insert the following definition:-

"Actively Charging" means an Electric Vehicle connected to a Charging Post for the

benefit of charging an Electric Vehicle until it is fully charged at which point the Electric Vehicle shall then disconnect from the Charging

Posts.

"Greater Manchester

Licensed Driver" means a Hackney Carriage or Private Hire Driver licensed by a Local

Authority within a Greater Manchester Borough.

"Licensed Electric Vehicle" means a licensed Hackney or Private Hire Electric Vehicle.

"Designated Licensed Electric Vehicle Bay"

means Two Charging Posts across three parking bays designated for

the use of a Greater Manchester Licensed Driver in a Licensed

Electric Vehicle

- 2. In Part II (Use of Parking Place & Charges) insert a new article 20B as follows:
  - 20A. Only a Licensed Electric Vehicle driven by a Greater Manchester Licensed Driver may park in a Parking Place which has been designated for the use of purposes of recharging a Licensed Electric Vehicle.
- 3. In Part III (Contraventions) insert a new article 32B as follows:-
  - 32B. No persons shall park an Electric Vehicle in a Licensed Electric Vehicle Bay which has been designated for the use of a Greater Manchester Licensed Driver or use the Charging Post in the Licensed Electric Vehicle Bay unless they are a Greater Manchester Licensed Driver and unless the Licensed Electric Vehicle is connected to a Charging Post and is Actively Charging.
  - 32C. No Greater Manchester Licensed Driver shall use a Designated Licensed Electric Vehicle Bay to charge their Licensed Vehicles unless they have the appropriate membership.
- 4. In Schedule 1 insert in the Class of Vehicle cell for the Ashton Mulberry Street Car Park:-
  - "Two Charging Posts across Three Parking Bays are designated for the use of Greater Manchester Licensed Drivers for the purposes of recharging their Electric Vehicles".
- 5. In Schedule 1 insert in the Class of Vehicle cell for the Ashton Union Street Car Park;-
  - "Two Charging Posts across Three Parking Bays are designated for the use of Greater Manchester Licensed Drivers for the purposes of recharging their Electric Vehicles".
- 6. In Schedule 1 insert in the Class of Vehicle cell for the Hyde Beeley Street Car Park:-
  - "Two Charging Posts across Three Parking Bays are designated for the use of Greater Manchester Licensed Drivers for the purposes of recharging their Electric Vehicles".
- 7. In Schedule 2 insert in the Charge cell for the Ashton Mulberry Street Car Park:-

"In addition to these Charges, a Greater Manchester Licensed Driver will also be subject to the following charges (inclusive of VAT) for charging their Licensed Electric Vehicles:
