

# Make a Nell NettleSPIKE mobile

## You will need:

A paper plate

Crayons such as green, orange and black

Felt tip pens for drawing

Orange tissue paper or paper that you've coloured orange

Black paper for the witch's hat

Wool

Scissors

Glue stick

Any coloured decorations such as sequins, stars, beads, paper shapes etc.

## Instructions

-  Take a paper plate and colour it green
-  Draw eyes and a nose onto the middle (your nose could have warts on it or can be crooked, you choose!)
-  Draw a mouth beneath the nose to show her ugly teeth
-  Make some hair using orange tissue paper
-  Draw a triangle onto black paper to make a hat and glue the ends of your hair onto one edge
-  Turn the triangle over and glue on the witch's head. Make sure your witch can see through her hair though as she will be flying on her broomstick later!
-  Add decorations to the hat
-  Make a hole at the top of her hat and thread some wool through to make a hanger for your mobile
