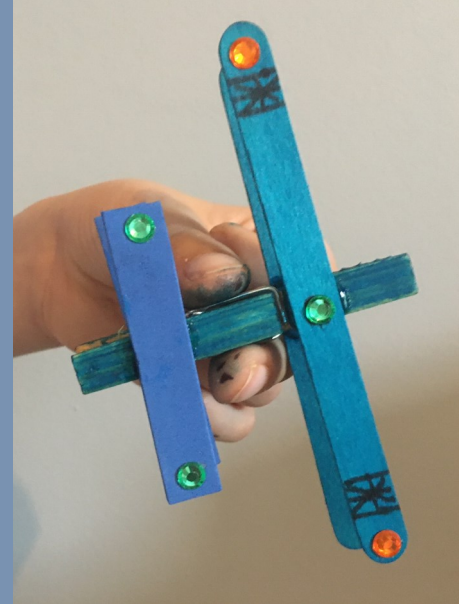


MAKE A PEG PLANE CLIP



In early years of aviation most airplanes were biplanes just like the Wright brothers first ever plane. Now it is time for you to build your own!

You will need: 2 standard lollipop sticks, 1 small lollipop stick * if you have not got small lollipop sticks, you could cut out of foam or card. 1 clothes peg, glue, stickers for decoration and felt tip pens. Optional: paint.

- * First you will need to colour in your clothes peg, we used felt tip pens, but if you want you could use paint.
- * Then decorate your lollipop sticks and small lollipop stick (or card/foam). Again we used felt tip pens and then added detail and stickers.
- * Once you have each of the different pieces decorated it is time to stick them together.
- * **TOP TIP:** You might want an adult to help you glue your plane together as it can be a little sticky! Glue the standard lollipop sticks towards the grip peg end, one to the top side of the peg, the other to the underside— quite close to the end as shown in the picture. Once they are in position, glue the smaller pieces—whether this is small lollipop sticks, foam or card pieces— to the other end of the peg as shown, these should be on the pinch end.

*The Wright Brothers' plane had a propeller on the front. Does yours need a propeller too? You could cut a small propeller out of card or foam and stick right on the end—its up to you!
