

# VE DAY BUNTING

**Friday 8 May 2020 will see the 75th anniversary of VE Day.**

**To make your VE Day bunting to commemorate you will need:**

**A pencil, A4 card, felt tip pens, cello tape, glue, string and scissors. \*If you have other materials at home please use.**

- \* To make the individual triangle shaped flags it is easier to draw 3 triangles on A4 card (please see photo below). **TOP TIP:** you could draw one triangle and make this a template to make lots more.
- \* You can use different coloured card if you have at home or use red, white and blue felt tip pens on white card. Remember these are your decorations so its up to you, be as creative as you want!
- \* Now cut out your triangles. Once cut out it is time to think about your design and how to decorate? If you need ideas maybe ask your family if anyone you know served during the war? Maybe a great grandparent? Draw them, or add a message of thanks, draw a union jack or a dove of peace!
- \* Once you have decorated you will be ready to string your flags to make bunting.
- \* Either hole punch the top corners and thread your string or you can simply cello tape your string to the top and back of the triangles. Remember you need the triangle points hanging down and to leave a bit of space between each flag.
- \* Ta daaaaa! Your bunting is now complete! Hang your bunting in your window for everyone to see!
