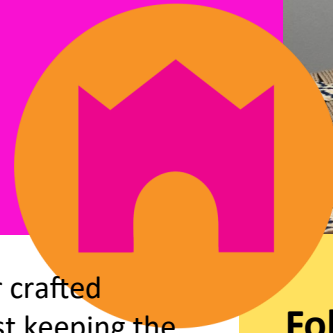

# MAKE A CARDBOARD BOX DEN



- \* Use an empty cereal box or paper bag as the base for your crafted 'Den'. You then need to add the features of your den whilst keeping the cereal box or paper bag flat. **TOP TIP:** When using a cereal box you need to open carefully down the side and work on the inside of the box which is plain.
- \* Now draw on the windows and doors OR you could cut out from paper/ card and stick on with glue. Please look at the picture for ideas.
- \* You can then finish off your den by adding a piece of A5 card as a roof.
- \* **Top TIP:** As cereal boxes tend to be tall you can cut down, cut so your den has a pitched roof etc. —please see photo.
- \* If adding a roof to the top of a flat cereal box fold the card horizontally so it sits on top of your box or paper bag and stick into position. If you only glue down one side you will be able to lift your roof and still use as a box or bag to carry and hold your figures and dolls.

Cardboard box or  
Paper bag  
Sheets of A4 card  
Tape  
Felt tip pens  
Glue  
Scissors  
Ruler

**If you have other arts and crafts materials you can add these too— perhaps pompoms and pipe cleaners**
