You can buy family fluoride toothpaste at your local supermarket.



INGREDIENTS

Aqua (Water), Hydrated Silica, Sorbitol, Sodium Lauryl Sulfate, Cellulose Gum, Aroma, Zinc Citrate, Sodium Benzoate, Sodium Fluoride, Sodium Saccharin, Menthol, Calcium Glycerophosphate, 2-Bromo 2-Nitropropane 1, 3-Diol., CI 27891.
Contains Sodium Fluoride 0.32% w/w (1450ppm F).

Always look for a toothpaste that contains between 1,350 - 1,500ppm (parts per million) of fluoride.



Top tips for using fluoride toothpaste:



 Parents or carers should use no more than a smear of toothpaste (a thin film of paste covering less than three-quarters of the child's brush) for children below 3 years of age.



- Parents or carers should use no more than a pea-size amount of toothpaste for children between 3 and 6 years.
- Brush all tooth surfaces at least twice a day; last thing at night or bedtime and on at least one other occasion.
- Spit out after brushing, don't rinse the mouth with water or mouthwash.
