PROCESSING YOUR INFORMATION

Information you share with the Council may be subject to processing by a third party organisation. We may undertake a Data Protection Impact Assessment prior to commencing any such activity and will always ensure that processing of your data falls under one of the following lawful bases';

- We have your consent;
- We have to fulfil a contractual obligation to you, or you have asked us to do something before entering into a contract;
- We have a legal obligation to process your personal data. Legal basis for access to Primary Care Mortality Database: Section 42(4) of the SRSA (2007) as amended by section 287 of the Health and Social Care Act (2012) and Regulation 3 of the Health Service (Control of Patient Information) Regulations 2002.
- We need to process your personal information to protect someone's life, this is known as a vital interest;
- We need to process your personal information 'in the exercise of public authority'. This covers the public functions, powers and obligations placed on the Council and set out in law;

You have the right to opt out of Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council receiving or holding your personal identifiable information. There are occasions where service providers will have a legal duty to share information, for example for safeguarding or criminal issues. The process for opting out will depend on the specific data is and what programme it relates to.
