Presentations and discussion will include:-

- Changes to the TASPB Policy and Procedure that will be implemented in 2022
- Changes to the MASH and how this supports Safeguarding
- Introduction of the Integrated Care Systems (ICS) and how this will impact on Safeguarding Practice in the future
- Partner organisations roles in safeguarding

Practitioners will have the opportunity to network and explore options for contacting organisations to support with Safeguarding Enquiries.
