MEET THE SAFEGUARDING LEAD, ADULT SOCIAL CARE, TAMESIDE COUNCIL

Tameside Adult Social Care have recently appointed a new Safeguarding lead in Adult Services, Lei-Anne Granger. Lei-Anne will be taking the lead in supporting the implementation of the new Safeguarding Framework at Tameside Council. The aim of the role is to lead on person centred safeguarding practice alongside the ongoing development of evidence based practice in an increasingly complex area of practice. Lei-Anne has worked for Tameside local authority for 14 years, during this time she has worked as a social worker and manager within the Integrated Neighbourhood Teams. Throughout her career Lei-Anne has gained valuable experience, skills and knowledge regarding safeguarding practice and has enjoyed supporting others in this area of practice. Lei-Anne is really passionate about ensuring the principles of 'Making Safeguarding Personal' are at the heart of practice and is excited to work with you all to continue to develop and improve safeguarding practice across adult social care.



UP AND COMING CHANGES

We are currently in the process of reviewing and updating the Safeguarding Adults Policy and Procedure. Implementation of the new Safeguarding Framework is planned for January 2021. The drivers for change have included, learning from reviews, feedback from professionals and recent research and guidance published by ADASS

Key changes will include:

- New methods of reporting concerns via the portal on Tameside MBC's website.
- Updated guidance on when to report concerns and how to involve Tameside MBC.
- Updated paperwork and guidance for completing Enquiries.
- Reviewed roles and responsibilities.
- Updated practice guidance.

RAISING AWARENESS

NATIONAL SAFEGUARDING WEEK 15 - 21 NOVEMBER 2021

National Safeguarding Week, takes place on the 15th to 21st of November 2021 and provides Tameside Adult Safeguarding Partnership Board (TASPB) with the opportunity to raise awareness.

TASPB will be working with partner organisations to raise awareness regarding a different Safeguarding theme each day of the week with the main focus being on the two development sessions planned for Tuesday the 16th and Wednesday 17th November 2021, 1pm to 4pm.

It is hoped that the events can be promoted throughout all organisations and a brief outline of what will be covered over the two days is detailed below.

16 NOVEMBER 2021

Tuesday the 16th of November will look at **“Learning from Safeguarding reviews”**

This event is to provide an opportunity for Practitioners to learn about the various legislation and local guidance for reviews in the context of Safeguarding:

- Safeguarding Adult Review
- Child Safeguarding Practice Review
- Domestic Homicide Review
- Learning Disability Review

The session will include learning from the most recent reviews that have taken place in Tameside. Practitioners involved in the Safeguarding Reviews will share their experience of their involvement in these Reviews.

17 NOVEMBER 2021

Wednesday 17th of November will look at

“Working in Partnership to Safeguard Adults at Risk of Abuse in Tameside”

This event is a forum for Practitioners to access updates regarding TASPb activity and gain further awareness to the pending changes to TASPb Policy and Procedures.

Organisations represented at TASPb will present the organisational changes and updates that directly impact on Partnership working in Adult Safeguarding.

Presentations and discussion will include:

- Opportunity to revisit the updates to TASPb guidance over the last 12 months
- Changes to the TASPb Policy and Procedure that will be implemented in 2022
- Changes to the MASH and how this supports Safeguarding
- Introduction of the ICS and how this will impact on Safeguarding Practice in the future
- Partner organisations roles in safeguarding

Practitioners will have the opportunity to network and explore options for contacting organisations to support with Safeguarding Enquiries.
