

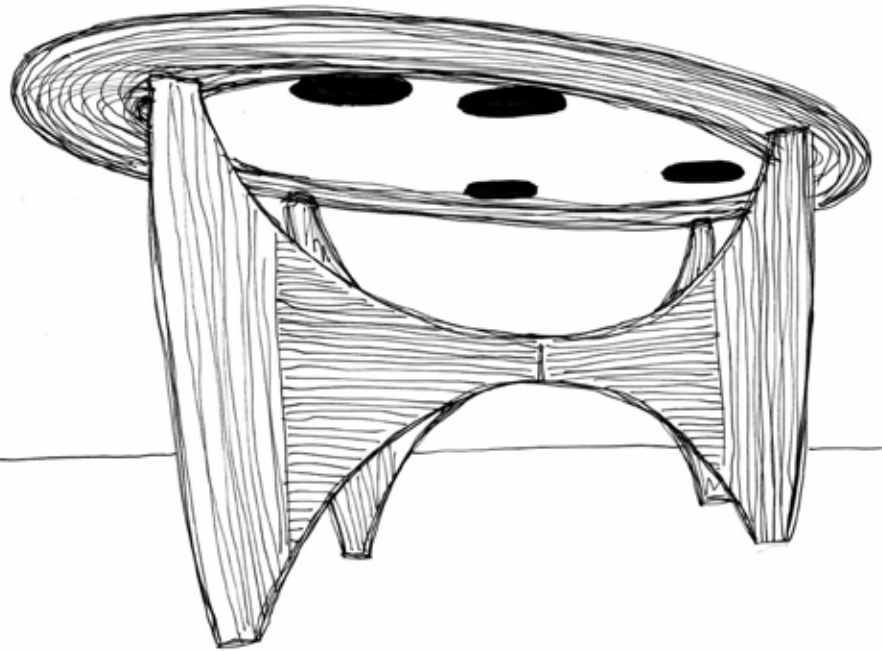


The pencil drawing on the left, looks directly down on a collection of drinking glasses.
