Family fun at home from Tameside Culture FIRE BREATHING DRAGON

Celebrate St George's Day with this cool fire breathing dragon!

- 1. Cut a kitchen towel tube in half. Paint or colour it green and Leave to dry.
- 2. Take two medium sized green circles of paper or card and stick on top of the kitchen towel tube for the dragons eyes. Stick on or paint 2 wiggle eyes.
- 3. Take two small green circles of coloured paper and stick to end of the tube at the top for the dragons nostrils.
- 4. Cut two long triangles from green paper for the dragons ears. Fold the bottom of the ear to make a tab and attach to one side of the top of the inside of the tube behind the eyes using glue dots. Repeat this step with the other ear and attach.
- 5. Cut two smaller triangles from white card for the dragons horns.
- 6. Take a sheet of red, orange and yellow tissue paper or colour thin paper and cut into strips.
- 7. Stick the ends of the strips of paper all around the inside of the end of the tube.
- 8. Take a deep breath and blow through the end of the tube where the dragons ears are and watch the flames blow!
