

Family fun at home from Tameside Culture

FIRE BREATHING DRAGON



Celebrate St George's Day with this cool fire breathing dragon!

1. Cut a kitchen towel tube in half. Paint or colour it green and Leave to dry.
2. Take two medium sized green circles of paper or card and stick on top of the kitchen towel tube for the dragons eyes. Stick on or paint 2 wiggle eyes.
3. Take two small green circles of coloured paper and stick to end of the tube at the top for the dragons nostrils.
4. Cut two long triangles from green paper for the dragons ears. Fold the bottom of the ear to make a tab and attach to one side of the top of the inside of the tube behind the eyes using glue dots. Repeat this step with the other ear and attach.
5. Cut two smaller triangles from white card for the dragons horns.
6. Take a sheet of red, orange and yellow tissue paper or colour thin paper and cut into strips.
7. Stick the ends of the strips of paper all around the inside of the end of the tube.
8. Take a deep breath and blow through the end of the tube where the dragons ears are and watch the flames blow!
