

# MAKE A 'BEST IN SHOW' ROSETTE

**Make your own 'Best in show' rosette to wear for doing or creating something amazing!**

Using the bottom of the cup as a template draw and cut out 8 circles from the tissue paper.

Draw and cut out two circles of card using the other end of the paper cup. One will be the back of the rosette. Onto this, glue the 8 pieces of tissue paper around its edge to look like a flower.

Decorate the second circle of card to show you are a winner such as 'First' or 'Best in Show'. This can be as creative as you like.

When this disc is finished, glue it to the middle of the 'petalled' card and let it dry.

Ask a grown up to add a pin to the back of the rosette so that you can wear it!



## You will need:

- Tissue paper in different colours
- Small pieces of card
- A paper cup as a template
- Glue sticks
