

# Christmas and New Year Recycling Arrangements

\*There will be no **brown bin collections** at all across the borough from **27 December 2021 until 7 January 2022**.\*

## Monday 27 December

If you are due a Green (general waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Wednesday 29 December.

If you are due a Black (comingled recycling waste) or a Blue (Paper recycling waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Friday 31 December.

## Tuesday 28 December

If you are due a Green (general waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Thursday 30 December.

If you are due a Black (comingled recycling waste) or a Blue (Paper recycling waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Tuesday 4 January.

## Monday 3 January

If you are due a Black (comingled recycling waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Wednesday 5 January.

If you are due a Green (general waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Thursday 6 January.

If you are due a Blue (Paper recycling waste) bin collection, it will be collected on Friday 7 January.

- Christmas trees can be left out with your brown bin for recycling from Monday 10 January.
