## National Adult Safeguarding Week

This year TASPb is to promote awareness of Adult Safeguarding during National Adult Safeguarding Week (November 22). The theme for this year is Domestic Abuse and expands on the work to inform the promotion of WEAAD (15th June 22).

There will be two development sessions taking place on Tuesday 22nd November 1-3pm and Thursday 24th November 10-12am. This will provide an opportunity for Practitioners to consider the overlaps between safeguarding and domestic abuse. The Safeguarding Development session will give Practitioners an opportunity to explore the different forms of Domestic Abuse and the tools to understand and respond effectively to domestic abuse in the context of Adult Safeguarding.
