NOTICE is hereby given that the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers the effects of which will be to introduce One Way Traffic on:-

- 1) Back Lane, from its junction with Market Street for a distance of 33 metres in a southerly direction.
- 2) Back Lane, from its junction with Jackson Street to its junction with Ashworth Lane in a southerly direction.
- 3) Market Place, from its junction with Ashworth Lane to its junction with Market Street in a north-easterly direction.

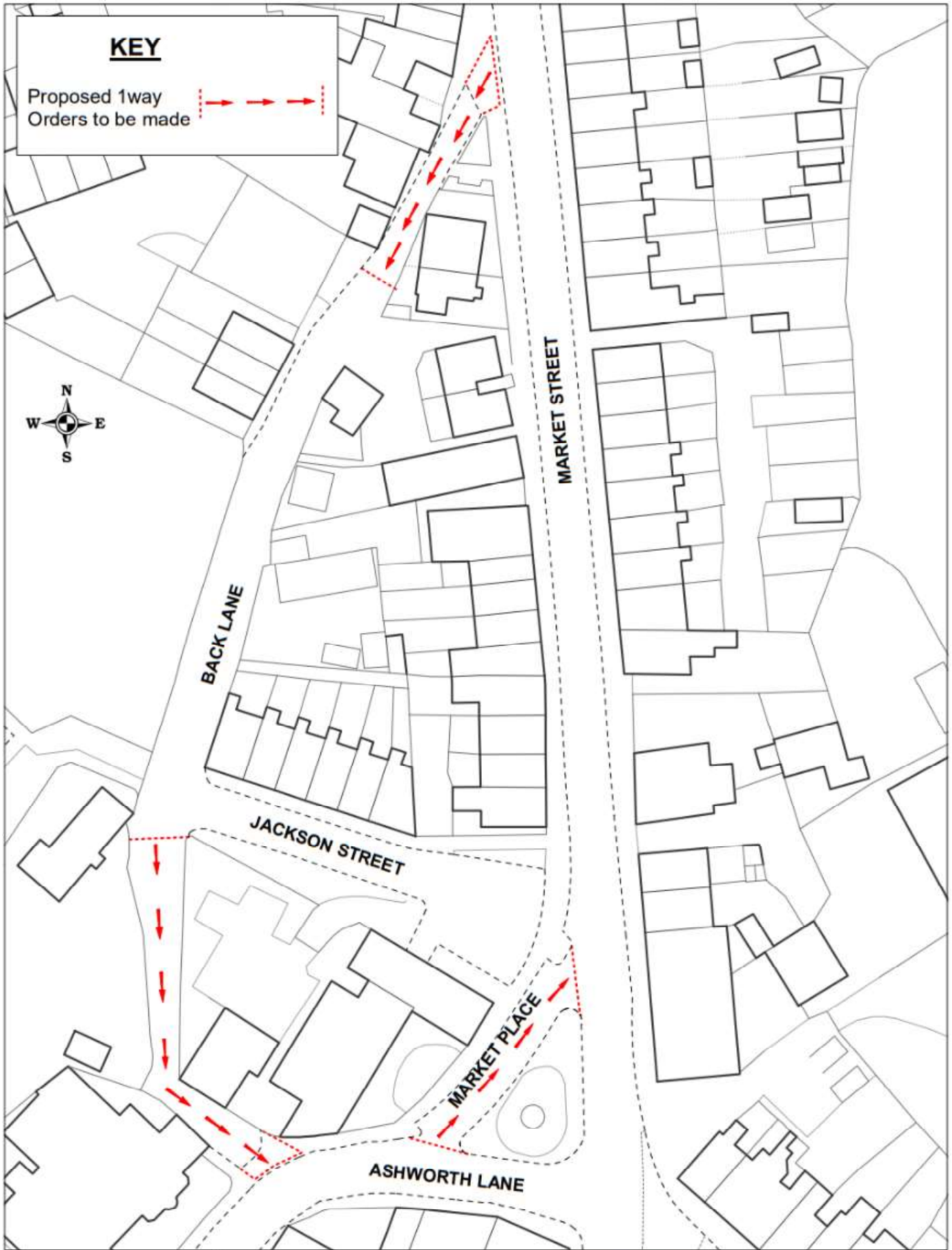

To implement one-way traffic working along sections of the public highways that are too narrow to accommodate two way traffic.

THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Articles 2 and 3 to this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any of the lengths of roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 2 of that Schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any vehicle being used for Ambulance, Fire Brigade or Police purposes if the observance of any provision of this Order would hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose on which it is being used on that occasion.
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

This Order will come into operation on <DATE> and may be cited as "**THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (BACK LANE AND MARKET PLACE, MOTTRAM) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023**".

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **One-Way Traffic Working**

#### **Column 1**

Back Lane from its junction with Jackson street to its junction with Ashworth Lane.

Back Lane from its junction with Market Street to a point 33 metres south of that junction.

Market Place from its junction with Ashworth Lane to its junction with Market Street.

#### **Column 2**

southerly direction

north-easterly direction
