Traffic Calming Features, Rose Hill Road Area, Ashton-under-Lyne

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to place a series of speed cushions within the Rose Hill Road Area of Ashton-under-Lyne.

The type, size and location of the speed humps are as follows: -

SPEED CUSHIONS (Width approx. 1.7m; height 75mm; 3.7m long)		
<u>Road</u>	<u>Ref. No.</u>	<u>Location</u>
Palace Road	C1	Centred about a point approximately 10 metres east of its westerly junction with Leech Avenue.
	C2	Centred about a point approximately 96 metres east of its westerly junction with Leech Avenue (outside no. 82 Palace Road).
	C3	Centred about a point approximately 14 metres west of its easterly junction with Leech Avenue (outside numbers 37 and 39 Palace Road).
	C4	Centred about a point approximately 79 metres west of its junction with Rose Hill Road (outside no. 16 Palace Road)
Leech Avenue	C5	Centred about a point approximately 29 metres west of its junction with Hadfield Crescent (outside no 46 Leech Avenue).
Rose Hill Road	C6	Centred about a point approximately 6 metres north of its junction with Palace Road (outside no.52 Rose Hill Road)

The speed cushions will be constructed to comply with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1996, and will be signed in accordance with the said Regulations and The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
