Statement of Reasons

A 20 mph speed limit is proposed to support the implementation of the already approved TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ROUGHTOWN ROAD, MOSSLEY) (ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020 by encouraging lower vehicle speeds and thereby enhancing road safety.

The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council, in exercise of their powers under section 84(1)(a) and (2) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to the vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the said Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
