- iii. Droylsden
- iv. Hyde
- v. Stalybridge

This Order is intended to come into operation on 10 May 2023 or as soon as possible thereafter.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL **TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)** **(AMENDMENT) (No.2) ORDER 2023**

Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to make the above named Order ("the Proposed Order") as an amendment to the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009. The proposed Order will:

1. Introduce cashless payment options at various locations in the following towns:
 - i. Ashton
 - ii. Denton
 - iii. Droylsden
 - iv. Hyde
 - v. Stalybridge

As set out in Schedule 1 to the Proposed Order.

The Proposed Order seeks to introduce alternative payment methods in addition to cash (coins) to make payment for parking more accessible to allow options to pay by coin, card and contactless payment.

On the 8th February 2023 the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council resolved to use its powers under Section 35 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the "Act", hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 is amended as set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.
2. The Order shall come into force on _____ and will be cited as the Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council (Off Street Parking Order) (Amendment) (No.2) 2023.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE 1

1. In Part I (General) insert in article 2 the following definition:-

"Cashless Payment" means a payment made in the car parks set out by credit, pre-paid and debit cards by using chip and pin or by tapping a sensor on a Pay and Display Machine and being issued with a ticket.

2. In Part II (Use of Parking Place & Charges) amend Article 6 to the 2009 Order to read:-

"6. The driver of a vehicle shall immediately after leaving a Vehicle in a Parking Place during Charging Hours pay the appropriate Charge as set out in Schedule 2 to this Order, by inserting a coin or coins of the appropriate value into the Apparatus provided, or by making a Cashless Payment where Cashless Payment facilities are available of the appropriate value into or onto the Apparatus provided, and complying with any instructions detailed upon or near that Apparatus, upon which a Parking Ticket will be issued for display in the Vehicle".
