## FEES

1. The fees may vary from year to year but will remain fixed during the period of the contract. There can be no refund of this fee.

## OPERATION OF PERMIT

2. Permits will only be issued for 6 months or 12 months period to cover either 5 Day ( Monday- Friday), 6 Day (Monday to Saturday) or 7 Day (Monday to Sunday). Failure to comply with the provision of the permit will entitle the Council to withdraw the permit.
3. A permit will be for a specific nominated car park and is non-transferable. Any application to an alternative car park will be considered by the Council and subject to an administration fee,

## RIGHT TO PARK

4. Contract holders will be entitled to use an unspecified space on the nominated car park between the hours of 8am to midnight. This does not, however, guarantee a space will be made available.

## TYPES OF VEHICLES PERMITTED TO PARK

5. Permits will only be valid for private cars and vans under 30-cwt net weight.

## DISPLAY OF CONTRACT PASS

6. The permit must be displayed on the vehicle windscreen. Failure to display on the vehicle windscreen will render the driver liable to penalties applicable by virtue of the previously stated statutory provisions.

## LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE, INJURY ETC.

7. Permits are issued on the clear understanding that vehicles, their accessories and contents are left in the car park entirely at the owners or the drivers risk regardless of any circumstances.

## Contraventions UNDER THE PARKING ORDERS

8. Failure to comply with the car parking regulations resulting in any of the following contraventions being committed will render the driver/owner of the vehicle liable to a Penalty charge Notice:-

- (i) Parked beyond the bay markings
- (ii) Failure to display a valid parking permit
- (iii) Parked in a car park without clearly displaying a valid permit
- (iv) Parking in a place reserved for disabled drivers without displaying a valid disabled badge.
- (v) Waiting in a parking place and using the vehicle in connection with the sale of goods or the selling of or offering for hire of services.

## WITHDRAWAL OF PERMIT

- 9 Tameside MBC reserves the right to withdraw the permit should the named car park become unavailable however, a suitable alternative car park or a proportional refund of the fee will be offered.
10. In the event that the permit holder is in breach of any regulation the permit may be withdrawn immediately, without rebate of any fee paid.
11. (i) The Council reserves the right at its absolute discretion to refuse to renew any permit.  
(ii) The Council reserves the right to withdraw any permit in the event of its misuse or noncompliance with the conditions of its use
