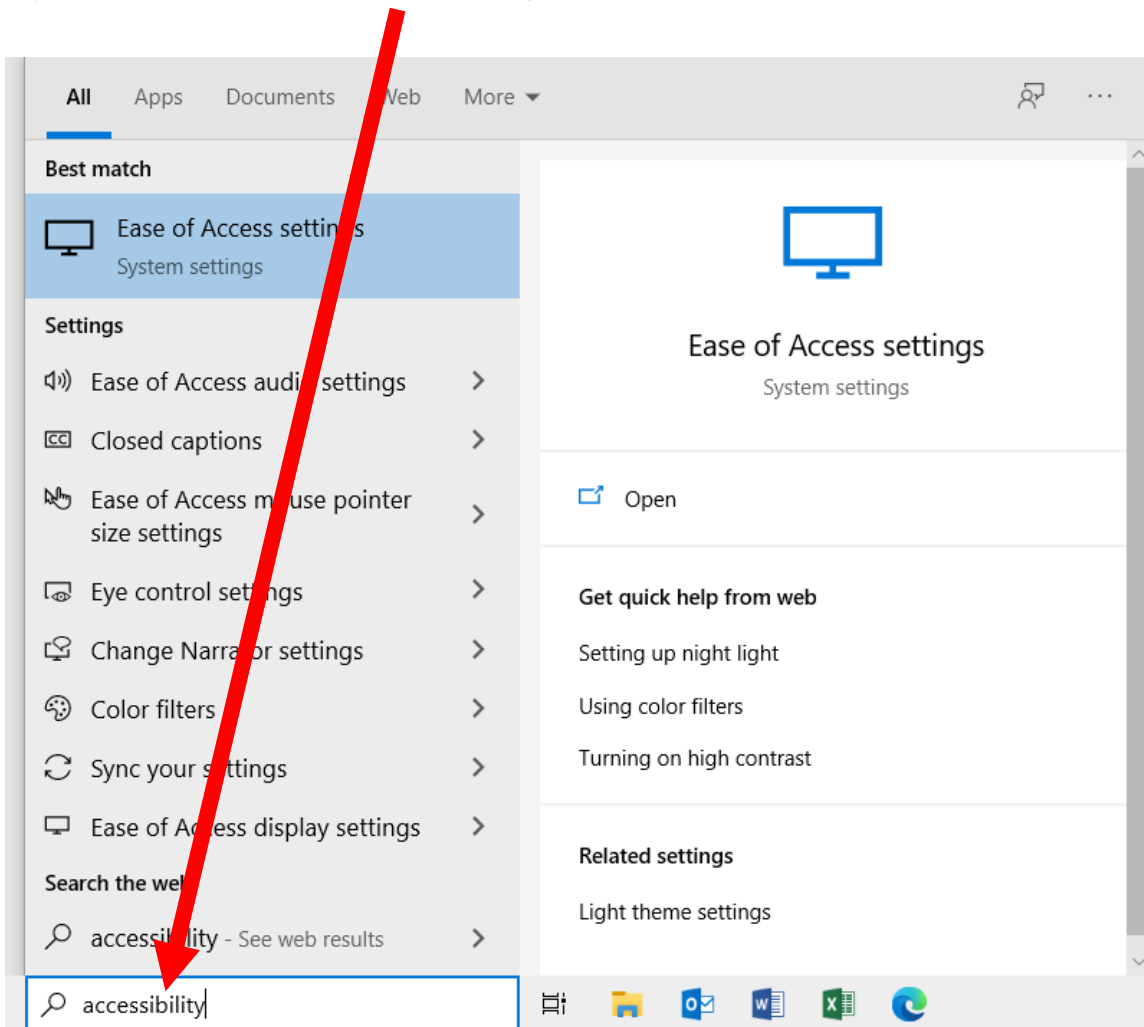
# Mouse pointer.

Press the **Windows key**

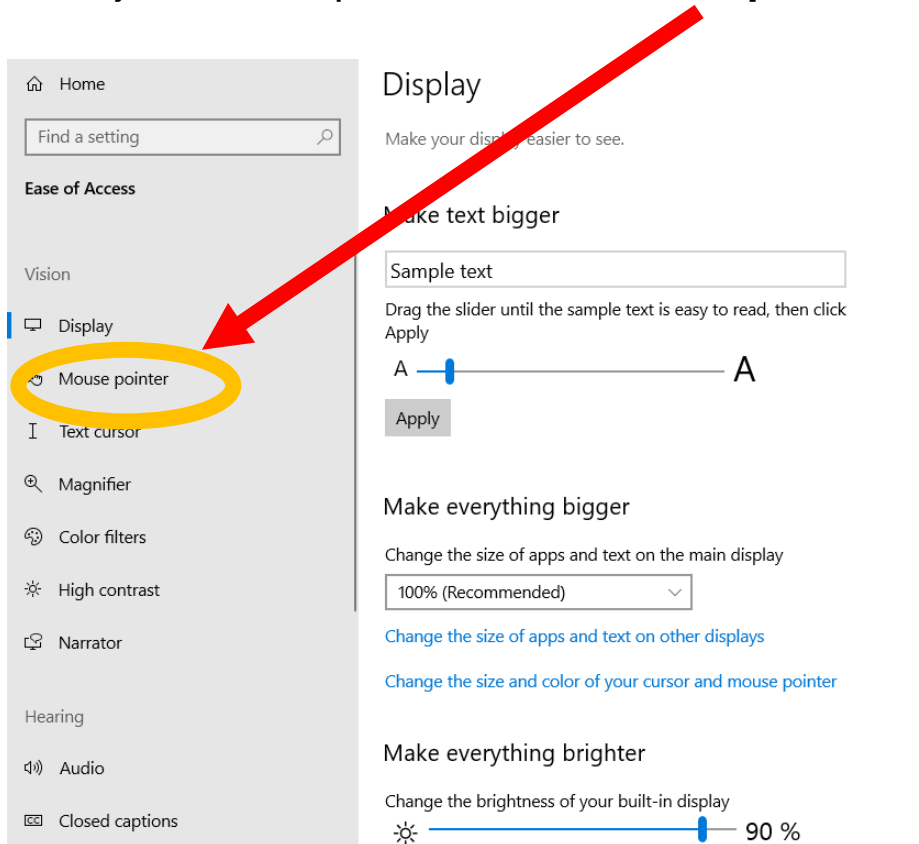


Type the word **Accessibility**

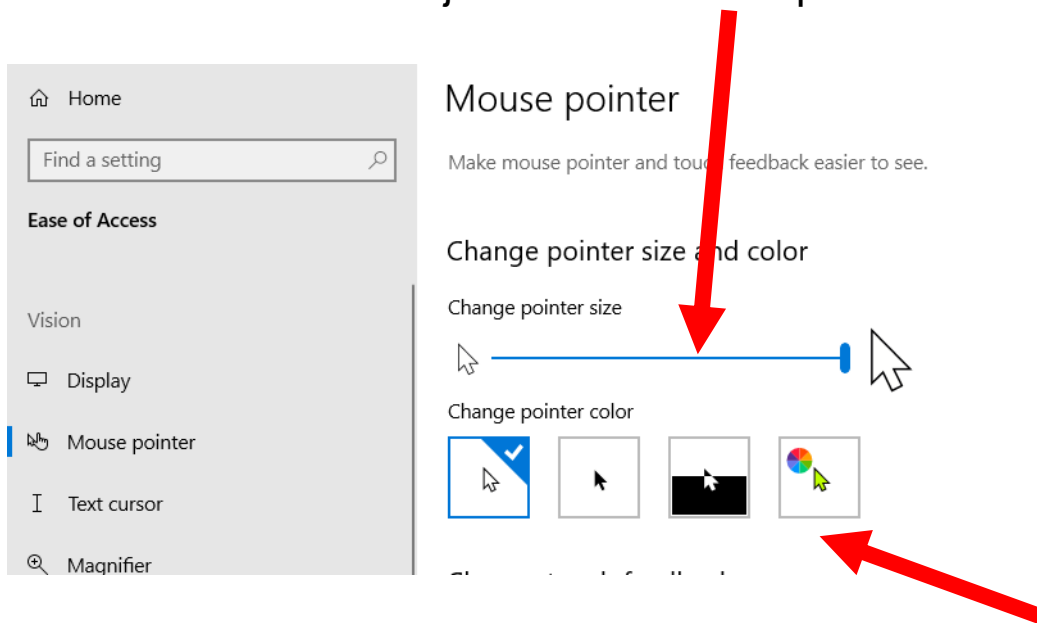


Various options will appear.

# Text cursor.

To change text cursor settings including thickness and indicator colour and size.

Select **Text cursor** from side menu.
