

The CASCADE project: a caregiver-led program to enhance creativity, social interaction, communication and spatial awareness in 6 – 12 years old with congenital visual impairment.



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WE ARE LOOKING FOR:

- Children with MILD to SEVERE-PROFOUND congenital VI due to eye and optic nerve impairment, (not due to brain damage, e.g. CVI).
- Children with LogMAR ≥ 0.3 or Snellen worse than 6/12
- Appropriate language for their age
- Children and their main caregiver willing to take part in a 6-week intervention* done on their computer or tablet at home!

*The intervention is held on a secure online platform (GDPR compliant). The duration of your participation should not exceed 6 weeks. The study has ethical approval from the Faculty Research Ethics Panel (SREP) at Anglia Ruskin University.

* The intervention will be done at the comfort of your home, no need to visit the university. Parents will receive access to an online App that will help them explore important topics related to communication, creativity, and spatial awareness. Children will learn new skills whilst playing games!
