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Updates following the Meeting:

An issue was raised by a residents regarding a number of large potholes on Oldham Street in Hyde. Oldham Street is inspected by a Highway Risk Inspector on a 12 month cycle with the next annual inspection due in September 2026. Following the resident's report being raised with the service, a Highway Engineer visited the area in July to identify any potholes which meet risk management intervention level. Two areas were identified (close to the speed humps outside house number 9 and 11). A works order was raised and the potholes were repaired the following day.
