

Approved Premise Ceremonies

The fee for Registrars to attend an approved premise in Tameside is £300 (subject to review each April).

Upon booking, Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council requires a non-refundable deposit of £100. This deposit is deducted from the approved premise fee so the outstanding balance is £200, which is payable 1 month prior to your ceremony date.

If you cancel your ceremony the deposit will not be refunded.

Within 3 months of booking you are able to move the date of the ceremony or move to another Approved Premise in Tameside.

It is essential you give your notice of intention to your local Register Office at least 28 clear calendar days before the ceremony and is only valid for one year. If you do not give notice your ceremony cannot take place

Register Office Ceremonies

The fee for a Register Office marriage/civil partnership is £50 (subject to review by the General Register Office)

If you wish to book a Register Office Wedding, Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council requires a non-refundable booking fee of £50. This fee will be deducted from the statutory wedding fee which means you do not need to pay any further fee when your ceremony takes place.

If you cancel the ceremony the fee will not be refunded.

Within 3 months of booking you are able to move the date of the ceremony.

It is essential you give your notice of intention to your local Register Office at least 28 clear calendar days before the ceremony and is only valid for one year. If you do not give notice your ceremony cannot take place.
